asking a youngster like you for love advice? You just tie me up that lucky love fly and watch me work. What kind of fly do you think I should have?"

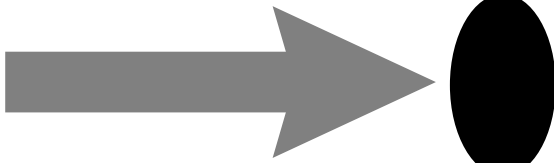
Marvin looked solemnly at the antique leprechaun.
