

walking, or a combination of those factors.

### Health

The risk of increased disease is a common concern. However, the producer panelists did not report significant health issues. Some of the reasons they gave included the ability to treat cows and calves in a timelier manner and improved ability to meet the cattle's nutritional needs. They also worked closely with their veterinarians to develop vaccination and treatment protocols.

Other items to consider are bio-security and minimizing stress factors. In a poster presented at the 2015 Midwest Animal Science meetings, researchers from Nebraska reported that treatment rates for calves in an intensively managed environment were 0 percent in year one but 84 percent in year two. These differences were attributed to weather stress (October snow) combined with exposure to a set of calves that had been shipped in to


the facility. calves. This points out that producers need to keep calves isolated if they are also bringing in other cattle.

"Agriculture has adapted to changing environmental and economic conditions many times in the past; the cow/calf business is no exception," Rusche said. 'Managing cows and calves more intensively in a semi-confinement system is a potential option to deal with the economic realities of the beef business and adapt to changing environmental conditions."
