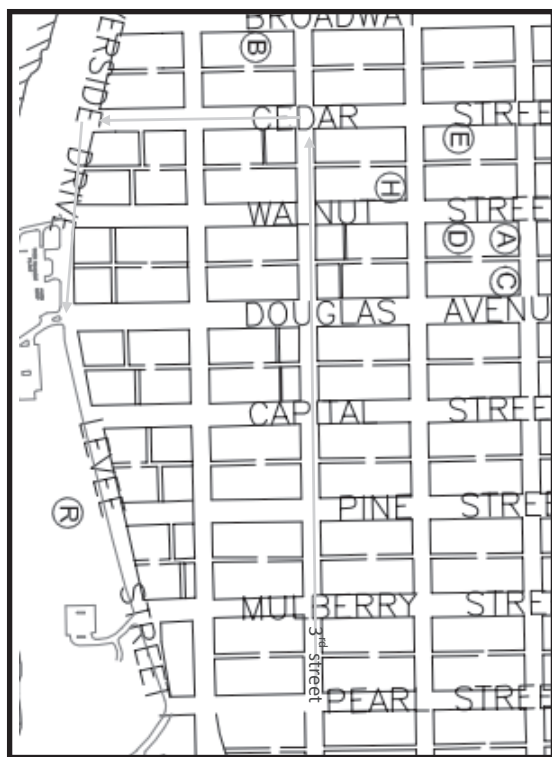




GO BUCKS!
